Booth Space: 10'x 10' **\$125**
Greater than 10'x 10' **\$150, not to exceed 10'x 20'**
Electricity **\$25, additional fee**

Dates: Wednesday, September 5th through Sunday, September 9, 2012.

Application Due: March 31, 2012. Notice of acceptance/decline will be mailed within 60 days of application deadline.

Refund Deadline: July 1, 2012. In order to receive a refund, vendors must notify the Meeker Classic of cancellation by July 1, 2012.

Items to Include with Application. **Incomplete applications will be returned and only accepted if returned in completed form by application deadline.**

1. A full description of merchandise to be sold at the show.
2. Photographs of merchandise and booth set-up (first time vendors)
3. If vending unit is towed, please submit drawing of hitch, length, openings, doors Display/serving side.
4. Signed Agreement, Waiver & Release (see attached page)
5. Check Payable to "Meeker Classic" for associated vendor fees
6. Copy of your Colorado Sales Tax License.

Criteria for Craft Vending Booth (applications will be juried. And the Meeker Classic reserves the right to reject items and/or vendors that are not related to this event. Items must be: ****Booth Fees will be cashed and refunded if application is not selected**

- a. **Handmade** (in the United States); **Made in the USA, OR**
- b. **Related to agriculture, sheep and wool industries or sheepdog trialing.**

Set-up Times – Towed vending units will need to set up **Thursday, September 6, 2012**, and other vendors will need to coordinate set up time with/upon approval of Vendor Coordinator. Please securely stake your tent and vending area, as we often have high winds. If you would like to set up earlier – you are welcome to do so. Just please contact the Vendor Coordinator.

Breakdown Times – Vendors may not breakdown until most spectators have left or upon permission granted by Vendor Coordinator.

Requests for Electricity must be made with initial application, and specify voltage required.

Licensing – Vendors must have a valid Colorado Sales Tax License and must keep a copy of such with them at the trial.

"Meeker Classic" and "Meeker Classic Sheepdog Championship Trials", along with the drawings of dog and sheep are trademarked, material and are not to be sold through vendor booths with the exception of vendors that have a working trademark agreement with the Meeker Classic Sheepdog Championship Trials, Inc.

Permits will not be granted for T-shirts, sweatshirts, cups or mugs for any items the Meeker Classic, in it's sole opinion, regards as inappropriate for sale. The Vendor Coordinator will notify you upon receipt of your application if the merchandise you wish to sell does not meet the approval criteria.

Booth Assignment & Location will be the sole discretion of the Vendor Coordinator and the Meeker Classic Board of Directors. Special needs for vendors should be stated in the original application and accommodation of those needs will be determined by the Vendor Coordinator.

Vendor Camping & Parking – Vendor camping & parking is in a designated area. Vendor campers will NOT have access to power. Generators must be turned off by 10 p.m. Each vendor will receive a parking pass for their vehicle. Vendor parking is close to the booth area BUT vendors CAN NOT park at their booth.

Stocking Booths/Inventory – Due to congestion in vending area, vendors may stock their booths (by vehicle or otherwise) before 8:30 a.m. **No motor vehicle traffic will be allowed to enter the vending area after that.**

No Pets Allowed – Please! Vendors do not bring your pets. Vendors are NOT allowed to sell pets during the trial. Failure to comply MAY result in a denied application in the future or may be asked to leave the trial.

Food & Craft Vendor Agreement, Waiver & Release

"Releasor", in consideration of being accepted as a Vendor at the 2012
Meeker Classic, hereby agrees, waives claims and releases the Meeker Classic Sheepdog Championship Trials
(Meeker Classic) as follows:

1. I have received a copy of the Vendor Rules (Food and/or Craft). I agree to comply with them and with any additional rules the Meeker Classic may post or give to me. I accept that I may be denied access to the site this year and in the future for failure to comply.
2. I understand the nature of this event and of this site. I understand that I, my assistants, and my property may be exposed to accident, theft, high wind or other Acts of God or other injury, loss, or damage while I am present as a vendor at the Meeker Classic, and that the Meeker Classic does not insure and is not responsible for insuring me, my assistants or my property against any of the foregoing. For myself and for my employees, I hereby waive any claim of any nature I may have against the Meeker Classic, the Town of Meeker, dog and livestock owners /handlers and any other person participating in or assisting with the Meeker Classic ((the "Releasees") arising out of or related to my participation as a vendor or my presence on the Meeker Classic site and hereby release the Releasees from liability for all claims, damages and causes of action that may arise from or be attributed to my participation as a vendor or presence otherwise on the Meeker Classic site. I personally assume all risks of injury to employees my assistants or me or damage to my property in connection with the Meeker Classic.
3. I acknowledge that the terms "Meeker Classic" and "Meeker Classic Sheepdog Championship Trials" and the logo above are trademarks and agree that I am not permitted to use the trademarks or to sell any item upon which such trademark appears unless I have been granted a written license by the Meeker Classic to do so. I further understand that the Meeker Classic may, in its sole discretion, refuse a license to any vendor for any reason or for no reason.

5. Failure to read the attached "Food/Craft Vendor Rules" is not defensible for failure to comply
